After assembly the trays are put in up to two layers in the collector's box.


Ordinary PVA glue is required when assembling each tray.









Tray 2a, 2b, 2c, 2d (the tray dimensions are identical)












Tray legend:

Tray 1 - paladin cards

Tray 2a, b, c, d - player trays

Tray 3 - clerics and labourers

Tray 4a - silver coins

Tray 4b - provision tokens

Tray 5a - outsider cards, and scheme cards, ally cards, & start player marker

Tray 5b - townsfolk and negotiate cards

Tray 6 - tavern, muster, wall, suspicion, debt and king's order & favour cards

Tray 7 - scouts, merchants, fighters, criminals, and vassals, diplomat & resource marker

Note: the small main board extension is placed on top of Tray 1. The remaining main board pieces are placed on top of Tray 7 together with the player board extensions. This will leave a level platform for the other boards and rule books to go on top.
